






Steel construction with ends representing two 'penny farthings' overlooking JCB cows.</b></p>  	<p><b>On Sustrans Coast to Coast path near Beamish Museum GR: NZ 217536</b></p>	<p><b>NE Members of TA, Houghton CC, friends and clubmates raised funds.</b></p>	<p><b>Powder-coated and robust so should not need attention.
